Circular to Money Service Operators Anti-Money Laundering / Counter-Terrorist Financing

United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation (Amendment) Regulation 2024

The United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation (Amendment) Regulation 2024 ("the Amendment Regulation"), made under the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537) ("UNSO"), was published in the Gazette (L.N. 24 of 2024) on 23 February 2024 with immediate effect.

The Amendment Regulation amends the United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation to give effect to certain decisions on sanctions under the United Nations Security Council Resolutions 2700 in respect of Haiti. The amendments renew the travel ban, financial sanctions and arms embargo, revise the scope of arms embargo, and reflect the new exemption requirements relating to arms embargo.
