Circular to Money Service Operators Licensing requirements for new/renewal application of a money service operator licence

"Local management office" and "local place for storage of books & records"

To enhance the anti-money laundering and counter-terrorist financing regulatory regime of the money service operator ("MSO") sector, with effect from 15 November 2019, the Customs and Excise Department ("C&ED") will implement the following new licensing requirements for new/renewal application of an MSO licence:

- (1) If an MSO licence applicant wishes to operate a money service <u>at particular premises</u>, the applicant is required to submit among others the information of <u>a local place for storage of books and records</u> in respect of its money service transactions.
- (2) If an MSO licence applicant wishes to operate money service <u>without</u> <u>particular premises</u>, the applicant is required to submit among others the information of <u>a local management office</u> and the information of <u>a local place</u> <u>for storage of books and records</u> in respect of its money service transactions.
